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Alarm Bells Ring As Global Food Prices Hit 2022 Highs, Perfect Storm Stokes New Inflation Shock

Global food prices have surged to their highest levels since 2022, signaling a potential new inflation shock for the worldwide economy. The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization reported that its global food-commodity index climbed 1.9% in August, reaching an average of 133.3. Major categories driving this increase include sugar, wheat, and various other essential commodities experiencing significant price spikes. Analysts attribute this surge to a perfect storm of adverse factors, including the El Niño weather phenomenon and rising costs for fertilizer and diesel. Disruptions in key trade routes, such as the Black Sea and the Strait of Hormuz, have further exacerbated supply chain constraints. Wall

DeepSeek's 160,000 Huawei Order Is A Real Threat To Nvidia In 2027

DeepSeek is constructing a massive data center in Ulanqab, China, featuring 160,000 Huawei Ascend 950DT AI processors. This facility represents the largest known cluster of Chinese-made AI silicon in the world, marking a significant shift in the global chip landscape. Huawei will supply the processors for inference tasks, while DeepSeek will continue using Nvidia processors for training due to Huawei's current limitations in that area. The deal highlights China's aggressive efforts to become self-sufficient in AI chip production amidst ongoing U.S. export controls. The Chinese

government acts as the ultimate gatekeeper by controlling import quotas, forcing domestic labs to wean off foreign silicon. Despite severe shortages of top-tier memory bottlenecking production, Huawei has secured this massive order, cementing its dominance in the inference market. Bloomberg estimates that roughly a quarter of the Ulanqab site will be occupied by unaccounted hardware, raising questions about the facility's true scale. Tech giants like Alibaba and Tencent are increasingly adopting Huawei hardware due to government policy instruments shaping the industry's trajectory. This move presents a real threat to Nvidia's market share in China by 2027 as local alternatives mature. The development underscores the deepening technological decoupling between the United States and China in critical sectors. Investors are watching closely to see how Nvidia adapts its strategy to retain relevance in the Chinese market. The success of the 950DT processors could validate China's state-led approach to semiconductor independence. Supply chain constraints remain a key risk factor for Huawei as it scales up production to meet demand. This deal marks a significant shift in China's AI chip landscape, with the government playing a key role in shaping the industry's trajectory.

SAP has a message for software doomsayers: The pendulum will swing back

SAP's stock has recovered from a 20% decline over the past year, defying the so-called SaaSocalypse that hit many software-as-a-service companies. Europa nu poate susține un război de uzură cu Rusia, avertizează experții

Security experts have issued a grim warning that Europe is currently incapable of sustaining a prolonged war of attrition with Russia. The assessment comes from defense officials and analysts gathered at a recent conference organized by the Munich Security Conference. They highlight a critical lack of public preparedness and growing anxiety among European populations as key vulnerabilities. Ministers of Defense from the E5 nations, including Germany, France, and Poland, have discussed the need for better coordination against hybrid threats. Wolfgang Ischinger, Director of the MSC, emphasized that the technology is not the primary issue, but rather the societal readiness. A former British cabinet member admitted that Western countries have been very poor at informing their publics about the scope of hybrid warfare. Diplomats have criticized leadership for failing to explain the threat, leading to unconvincing campaigns to reduce social spending for defense. The blurring of the East-West divide has allowed Moscow to exploit public fears and anxieties effectively. There are concerns that NATO might block the consolidation of a stronger European component within the alliance. Experts suggest that Europe must coordinate better to protect itself against hybrid warfare tactics. The growing Russian threat could affect the integrity and stability of the entire continent. Public sentiment remains a significant hurdle in mobilizing resources for a potential long-term conflict. Officials stress that without addressing these societal weaknesses, military capabilities alone will not suffice. The warning underscores the urgent need for a strategic shift in how European nations approach defense communication. Ultimately, the consensus is that current preparations are insufficient for a sustained conflict scenario.

Romanians are significantly reducing their food purchases as price increases continue to erode purchasing power across the country. Financial consultant Adrian Negrescu describes the situation as resembling the Romanian version of The Hunger Games. Un avion de vânătoare s-a prăbușit în timpul unui show aviatic în Grecia

A Greek Air Force fighter jet crashed on Saturday during a flying display near Athens, causing a fire and releasing large plumes of black smoke. The aircraft was a Phantom F-4 with two seats, participating in the Athens Flying Week event. Tragically, both pilots on board were killed in the incident, according to authorities. The crash occurred during a low-altitude maneuver in front of thousands of spectators. Fortunately, no one in the crowd was injured despite the proximity of the accident. A fire broke out in the vicinity of the base in Tanagra, 60 kilometers north of Athens. Eleven

aircraft and helicopters were deployed to fight the fires along with 85 firefighters. The fire was kept at a safe distance from the crowd at the Athens Flying Week event. The incident has raised concerns about safety and emergency response procedures in Greece. The cause of the crash is yet to be determined and remains under investigation. Officials from the Greek Air Force have apologized and are cooperating with the investigation. The aircraft is an older model that was used from 1960 to 2001, raising questions about maintenance. The accident is being treated as an accident rather than a terrorist attack. Emergency services including firefighters and ambulances were deployed to the scene immediately. Revolta șoferilor români de Uber contra companiei ajunge într-un proces la Amsterdam

A lawsuit filed by 240,000 Uber drivers from six countries, including Romania, against the company is proceeding in Amsterdam. US and Iran trade retaliatory attacks on ships as conflict flares

The US and Iran engaged in a retaliatory naval clash on Saturday. The US military targeted and disabled two Iranian-linked oil tankers. Iran attacked three US-affiliated vessels in response. This incident marks the latest escalation in the six-month conflict. There was a relative calm for a month prior to this exchange. The US Central Command claimed to have successfully evaded Iranian attacks on two US warships. Iran's state media confirmed the strikes and said Tehran targeted US ships in response. The conflict highlights the deteriorating relationship between the two nations. This has raised concerns about regional stability and oil prices. The incident comes as President Donald Trump dismissed the conflict as small potatoes. There appears to be little apparent progress towards ending the war. Defence Secretary Pete Hegseth tweeted on social media promising to destroy and sink Iranian oil tankers. This rhetoric has added to the tension in the region. TV presenter among 11 sentenced to death in Egypt drugs case

Sarah Khalifa, a 39-year-old Egyptian television presenter, has been sentenced to death. She was convicted alongside 11 others in a high-profile drugs case. The sentence handed down by the court is death by hanging. Khalifa is known for her TV programme called Mission Impossible. She has denied the charges brought against her. The defendants were part of a criminal gang that imported ingredients to make drugs. The group also possessed illegal firearms and munitions. The court heard evidence of over 750kg of seized narcotics and raw materials. Electronic evidence including conversations and video clips was also presented. The verdict was confirmed after a religious opinion from the grand mufti of Egypt. This religious opinion is a legal requirement for death sentence cases. The sentencing matters because it highlights the use of the death penalty in Egypt. The country has been criticized for its human rights record. Amnesty International reported that 23 of 492 death sentences in 2025 were carried out in Egypt. The verdict can be appealed by the defendants but the outcome remains uncertain.

Seattle Times Sues Microsoft and OpenAI Over AI Training

The Seattle Times has officially sued Microsoft and OpenAI regarding their AI practices. The newspaper alleges that the tech companies trained their AI on its journalism without consent. FSF Joins Bluesky Despite Nonfree JavaScript Concerns

The Free Software Foundation has announced its presence on Bluesky. This social media platform has not been widely adopted by the fediverse community. This is due to its non-free JavaScript usage. Despite this, the FSF is utilizing Bluesky to reach people who may not be aware of software freedom. Bluesky is a federated platform distinct from other services. It uses its own AT protocol rather than ActivityPub. The FSF has chosen to sign up for Bluesky despite its non-free JavaScript usage. This allows them to reach new audiences effectively. However, hosting a Bluesky Personal Data Server is considered more difficult. It is also more resource-intensive than other options. The Bluesky codebase is largely freely licensed for users. This allows users to run and modify parts of the codebase. The FSF is advising its supporters to follow them on both Bluesky and Mastodon. By joining Bluesky, the FSF aims to expand its reach. They intend to promote software freedom through this channel. The decision balances principle with practical outreach goals. Community reaction has been mixed regarding the JavaScript concerns. Nevertheless, the organization remains committed to spreading its message. This move signals a shift in engagement strategy.
